Drinking Fountain created in sandstone with water faucets at two heights for accessibility & caved fossils representing the geology of Tunbridge Wells.

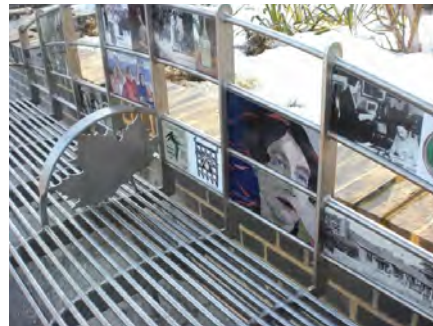

Tim Ward of Circling the Square created the art benches, slate mosaic paving and stone carved floorscape for this scheme. The overriding theme was to connect with Epping Forest and celebrate notable people of the area – this included benches on Winston Churchill, Sylvia Pankhurst and William Morris.

Hand carved blocks creating rondel seats for a new-build housing development in n Bedfordshire. The relief surface representing locally relevant images and provides a play element.

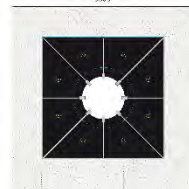
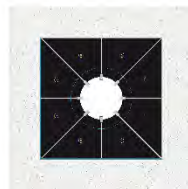
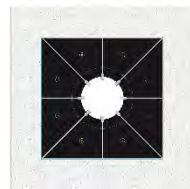
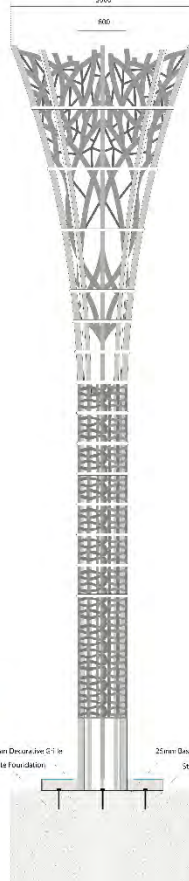
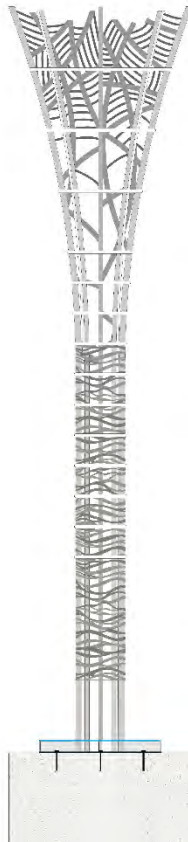
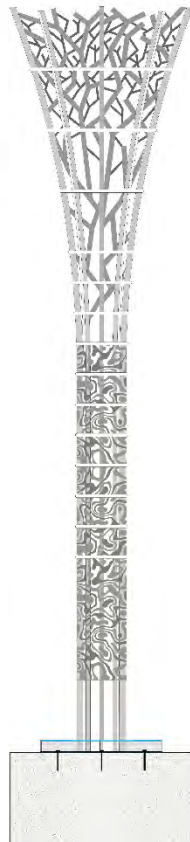
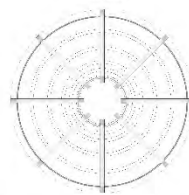
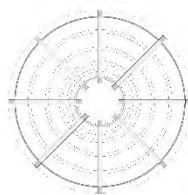
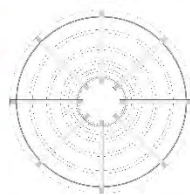


Lower Stondon Footpath Trail Markers Client: Bloor Homes
